Luke 5:12 And it happened when He was in a certain city, that behold, a man who was full of leprosy saw Jesus; and he fell on his face and implored Him, saying, “**Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean.**” Then He put out His hand and touched him, saying, “**I am willing; be cleansed.**” Immediately the leprosy left him. (NKJV)

Luke 5:12-13 While He was in one of the towns, there came a man full of (covered with) leprosy; and when he saw Jesus, he fell on his face and implored Him, saying, Lord, **if You are willing**, You are able to cure me and make me clean. And [Jesus] reached out His hand and touched him, saying, **I am willing**; be cleansed! And immediately the leprosy left him. (AMP)

*In the Living Bible is written Jesus said **OF COURSE I WILL.***

Is it God's Will to heal today? Is it God's Will to heal all? Is it God's Will to heal you now? How can you find the Will of God? How can you ascertain the Will of God? You find the Will of God from The Word of God.

Jesus is the Living Word of God. Jesus is the Will of God.

You can't judge the Will of God by what has happened or hasn't happened.

God gave us a free will. God gave us the ability to choose. This is why there is tragedy in the earth. Man can choose to disobey God. Man's disobedience is not the Will of God.

John 6:38 For I have come down from heaven, **not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.** (NKJV)

John 14:10 Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but **the Father who dwells in Me does the works.** (NKJV)

John 8:28-29 Then Jesus said to them, "When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am He, and that **I do nothing of Myself**; but as My Father taught Me, I speak these things. And He who sent Me is with Me. The Father has not left Me alone, for **I always do those things that please Him.**" (NKJV)

The Ministry of Jesus (everything He said and everything He did) is the direct revelation of the unchanging Will of God for all men for all time. Everything that Jesus did demonstrated the Will of God for all time. Jesus didn't do His own will. A large part of His ministry was healing.

If you read what Jesus said and did in the four gospels you know this is the Will of God.

Matthew 4:23-24 And Jesus went about all Galilee, **teaching** in their synagogues, **preaching** the gospel of the kingdom, and healing **all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people.** Then His fame went throughout **all** Syria; and they brought to Him **all sick people** who were afflicted with various diseases and torments, and those who were demon-possessed, epileptics, and paralytics; and **He healed them.** (NKJV)

Matthew 8:16-17 When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and **healed all** who were sick, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: "He Himself took our infirmities And bore our sicknesses." (NKJV)

Luke 4:40 When the sun was setting, **all** those who had any that were sick with various diseases brought them to Him; and He laid His hands on **every one of them and healed them.** (NKJV)

*If you can't find the Will of God looking at Jesus, where are you going to look for the Will of God? **We are looking at the unchanging will of God for all men for all time.***

All of them. Everyone of them. Say this to yourself. All of them. Everyone of them. Jesus healed all of them. Jesus healed everyone of them.

Matthew 9:35 Then Jesus went about **all** the cities and villages, **teaching** in their synagogues, **preaching** the gospel of the kingdom, and **healing every sickness and every disease among the people.** (NKJV)

Matthew 9:35 And Jesus went about **all** the cities and villages, **teaching** in their synagogues and **proclaiming** the good news (the Gospel) of the kingdom and **curing all kinds of disease and every weakness and infirmity.** (The Amplified Bible)

Matthew 10:1 And when He had called His twelve disciples to Him, He gave them power over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to **heal all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease.** (NKJV)

Matthew 12:15 But when Jesus knew it, He withdrew from there. And great multitudes followed Him, and He **healed them all.** (NKJV)

A multitude is thousands of people. When Jesus fed the multitude it was 5,000 men.

We have not found anyone who it was not God's Will to heal. Out of all these multitudes we haven't found one where it says it isn't always His Will. He healed them all is the Will of God.

Matthew 14:14 And when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and He was **moved with compassion for them, and healed their sick.** (NKJV)

Matthew 14:34-36 When they had crossed over, they came to the land of Gennesaret. And when the men of that place recognized Him, they sent out into **all** that surrounding region, brought to Him **all who were sick**, and begged Him that they might only touch the hem of His garment. **And as many as touched it were made perfectly well.** (NKJV)

Luke 6:17-19 And He came down with them and stood on a level place with a crowd of His disciples and a great multitude of people from all Judea and Jerusalem, and from the seacoast of Tyre and Sidon, who came to **hear Him and be healed of their diseases**, as well as those who were tormented with unclean spirits. **And they were healed.** And the whole multitude sought to touch Him, for power went out from Him and **healed them all.** (NKJV)

Just because something happens does not mean that was the Will of God. Do you know anyone who died without receiving Jesus as their Lord and Savior? Was that the Will of God? Absolutely not. God sent His Only Son to express His Will to have them saved.

Matthew 15:30-31 Then **great multitudes** came to Him, having with them the **lame, blind, mute, maimed, and many others**; and they laid them down at Jesus' feet, and **He healed them.** So the **multitude** marveled when they saw the **mute speaking**, the **maimed made whole**, the **lame walking**, and the **blind seeing**; and they glorified the God of Israel. (NKJV)

You have to believe this when you don't see it. You have to proclaim it when things around you tell you it isn't so. You believe and then you see. You decide the Bible is true and believe it is so. This is the Will of God.

Matthew 19:2 And great multitudes followed Him, and **He healed them there.** (NKJV)

Matthew 21:12-14 Then Jesus went into the temple of God and drove out all those who bought and sold in the temple, and overturned the tables of the money changers and the seats of those who sold doves. And He said to them, "It is written, 'My house shall be called a house of prayer,' but you have made it a 'den of thieves.'" Then the **blind and the lame** came to Him in the temple, and **He healed them.** (NKJV)

If He used to heal them all He is still healing them all. Hold out for the perfect Will of God. Don't settle for anything less.
