**Luke 5:12** And it happened when He was in a certain city, that behold, a man who was full of leprosy saw Jesus; and he fell on his face and implored Him, saying, **“Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean.”**

Then He put out His hand and touched him, saying, **“I am willing; be cleansed.”** Immediately the leprosy left him. (NKJV)

**Luke 5:12-13** While He was in one of the towns, there came a man full of (covered with) leprosy; and when he saw Jesus, he fell on his face and implored Him, saying, Lord, **if You are willing**, You are able to cure me and make me clean. And [Jesus] reached out His hand and touched him, saying, **I am willing**; be cleansed! And immediately the leprosy left him. (AMP)

**Exodus 15:23-26** Now when they came to Marah, they could not drink the waters of Marah, for **they were bitter**. Therefore the name of it was called Marah. And **the people complained** against Moses, saying, “What shall we drink?” So he cried out to the Lord, and the Lord showed him a tree. When he cast it into the waters, the waters were made sweet. There He made a **statute and an ordinance** for them, and there He tested them, and said, “If you diligently heed the voice of the Lord your God and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have brought on the Egyptians. **For I am**

**the Lord who heals you.”** (NKJV) *Doubt despairs complains and is sad. Faith rejoices gives thanks and is glad. Can the bitter be made sweet? Jesus hung on a tree. Jesus took our bitter waters and made them sweet. He said I AM Jehovah Rapha. 7495 [rapha', raphah /raw-faw/] v. A primitive root; TWOT 2196; GK 8324; 67 occurrences; AV translates as “heal” 57 times, “physician” five times, “cure” once, “repaired” once, and translated miscellaneously three times. 1 to heal, make healthful. 1a (Qal) to heal. 1a1 of God. 1a2 healer, physician (of men). 1a3 of hurts of nations involving restored favour (fig). 1a4 of individual distresses (fig). 1b (Niphal) to be healed. 1b1 literal (of persons). 1b2 of water, pottery. 1b3 of national hurts (fig). 1b4 of personal distress (fig). 1c (Piel) to heal. 1c1 literal. 1c2 of national defects or hurts (fig). 1d (Hithpael) in order to get healed (infinitive). Strong, J. (1995). *Enhanced Strong's Lexicon. Woodside Bible Fellowship. When He says I AM the Lord who heals you, no one has a right to say He doesn't. This is covenant. Exodus 23:25-26* So you shall serve the Lord your God, and **He will bless your bread and your water. And I will take sickness away from the midst of you.** No one shall suffer miscarriage or be barren in your land; **I will fulfill the number of your days.** (NKJV) **Exodus 23:24** You shall not bow down to their gods, nor serve them, nor do according to their works; but you shall utterly overthrow them and completely break down their sacred pillars. (NKJV) *Testament is a Latin word that replaced COVENANT. A covenant is a formal solemn binding agreement. Committed. Covenant is**

*everlasting. Deuteronomy 7:9* Therefore know that the Lord your God, He is God, the faithful God who **keeps covenant** and mercy for a **thousand generations** with those who love Him and keep His commandments; (NKJV) *One of the greatest things you do for your children and grandchildren is serve God. Your obedience gives God a legal and moral right to do what He said He would do in the covenant. Deuteronomy 7:12-15* Then it shall come to pass, because you listen to these judgments, and keep and do them, that the Lord your God will **keep with you the covenant and the mercy** which He swore to your fathers. And He will love you and bless you and multiply you; He will also bless the fruit of your womb and the fruit of your land, your grain and your new wine and your oil, the increase of your cattle and the offspring of your flock, in the land of which He swore to your fathers to give you. You shall be blessed above all peoples; there shall not be a male or female barren among you or among your livestock. And the Lord will take away from you all sickness, and will afflict you with none of the terrible diseases of Egypt which you have known, but will lay them on all those who hate you. (NKJV) *Well that's just for the Jews. Romans 2:28-29* For he is not a Jew who is one outwardly, nor is circumcision that which is outward in the flesh; but he is a Jew who is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the Spirit, not in the letter; whose praise is not from men but from God. (NKJV) *Glory I am a Jew. Galatians 3:7-9* Therefore know that only those who are of faith are sons of Abraham. And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify

the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel to Abraham beforehand, saying, "In you all the nations shall be blessed." So then those who are of faith are blessed with believing Abraham. (NKJV) *I am a child of Abraham by faith in Jesus.* **Galatians 3:26-29** For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus. And if you are Christ's, then **you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.** (NKJV) **Galatians 6:15-16** For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but a new creation. And as many as walk according to this rule, peace and mercy be upon them, and upon the **Israel of God.** (NKJV) *New creatures are the Israel of God. I am the Israel of God.* **Hebrews 8:6-11** But now He has obtained a more excellent ministry, inasmuch as He is also Mediator of a **better covenant**, which was established on **better promises.** For if that first covenant had been faultless, then no place would have been sought for a second. Because finding fault with them, He says: "Behold, the days are coming, says the Lord, when I will make a **new covenant with the house of Israel** and with the house of Judah—not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they did not continue in My covenant, and I disregarded them, says the Lord. For **this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel** after those days, says the Lord: I will put My laws in their mind and

write them on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. (NKJV) *We've got everything they had PLUS! Glory to God. I AM Jehovah Rapha still applies to you. Healing is bought and paid for.*
