REVIEW

Luke 5:15 But so much the more went there a fame abroad of him: and great multitudes **came together to hear, and to be healed** by him of their infirmities. (KJV)

Luke 5:15 But so much the more the news spread abroad concerning Him, and great **crowds kept coming together to hear [Him] and to be healed by Him** of their infirmities. (The Amplified Bible)

Luke 6:17-19 And He came down with them and stood on a level place with a crowd of His disciples and a **great multitude** of people from all Judea and Jerusalem, and from the seacoast of Tyre and Sidon, **who came to hear Him and be healed of their diseases**, as well as those who were tormented with unclean spirits. And they were healed. And the whole **multitude sought to touch Him, for power went out from Him and healed them all.** (NKJV)

If He is just healing people by His power then there is no need the HEAR. His own home town did not hear the words He gave them.

Proverbs 4:20-23 My son, **give attention** to my words; **Incline your ear** to my sayings. **Do not let them depart from your eyes; Keep them in the midst of your heart;** For they are life to those who find them, And health to all their flesh. **Keep your heart**

with all diligence, For out of it spring the issues of life. (NKJV)

Proverbs 4:20-23 My son, **pay attention** to my words. **Open your ears** to what I say. **Do not lose sight** of these things. **Keep them deep within your heart** because they are **life to those who find them and they heal the whole body.** Guard your heart more than anything else, because the source of your life flows from it.(GOD'S WORD Translation)

Your entire life and existence is the result of our response to His Words. Our life is totally based upon our response.

The authority, the integrity, the value of God's Word. This is so important. You must see it as the final authority on everything.

Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is **living and powerful**, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a **discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.** (NKJV)

Our entire life is a result of our response to the Word of God. Most of us didn't respond correctly the first time. Everything that is going on in this planet is a result of everybody's response to the Word of God. He's looking for a harvest of those who responded to His Words.

LIVING WORD OF GOD

Revelation 19:11-13 Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called **Faithful and True**, and **in righteousness He judges** and makes war. **His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns.** He had a **name written that no one knew except Himself.** He was **clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God.** (NKJV)

1 John 1:1-4 That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and **our hands have handled, concerning the Word of life**—the life was manifested, and we have seen, and bear witness, and declare to you **that eternal life which was with the Father and was manifested to us**—that which we have seen and heard we declare to you, that you also **may have fellowship with us**; and truly our fellowship is with the Father and with His Son Jesus Christ. And these things we write to you that your joy may be full. (NKJV)

1 Peter 1:23-25 having been born again, not of corruptible seed **but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever**, because “All flesh is as grass, And all the glory of man as the flower of the grass. The grass withers, And its flower falls away, **But the word of the Lord endures forever.**” (NKJV)

John 1:1-8 In the beginning was the **Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.** He was in the beginning with God. **All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made** that was made. In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it. (NKJV)

BREAD OF LIFE

Matthew 4:1-4 Then **Jesus was led up by the Spirit** into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. And when He had fasted forty days and forty nights, afterward He was hungry. Now when the tempter came to Him, he said, “**If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread.**” But He answered and said, “**It is written, ‘Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.’**” (NKJV)

Deuteronomy 8:3 So He humbled you, allowed you to hunger, and fed you with manna which you did not know nor did your fathers know, that He might make you know that **man shall not live by bread alone; but man lives by every word that proceeds from the mouth of the Lord.** (NKJV)

John 6:26-66 Jesus answered them and said, “Most assuredly, I say to you, you seek Me, not because you saw the signs, but because **you ate of the loaves and were filled.** Do not labor for the food which perishes, **but for the food which endures to everlasting life, which the Son of Man will give you,** because God the Father has set His seal on Him.” Then they said to Him, “What shall we do, that we may work the works of

God?" Jesus answered and said to them, **"This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He sent."** Therefore they said to Him, "What sign will You perform then, that we may see it and believe You? What work will You do? Our fathers ate the manna in the desert; as it is written, **'He gave them bread from heaven to eat.'** " Then Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, **Moses did not give you the bread from heaven, but My Father gives you the true bread from heaven. For the bread of God is He who comes down from heaven and gives life to the world.**" Then they said to Him, "Lord, give us this bread always." And Jesus said to them, **"I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst.** But I said to you that you have seen Me and yet do not believe. All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will by no means cast out. For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me. This is the will of the Father who sent Me, that of all He has given Me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up at the last day. And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have everlasting life; and I will raise him up at the last day." The Jews then complained about Him, because He said, "I am the bread which came down from heaven." And they said, "Is not this Jesus, the son of Joseph, whose father and mother we know? How is it then that He says, 'I have come down from heaven?'" Jesus therefore answered and said to them, "Do not murmur among yourselves. No one can come to Me unless

the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up at the last day. It is written in the prophets, 'And they shall all be taught by God.' Therefore everyone who has heard and learned from the Father comes to Me. Not that anyone has seen the Father, except He who is from God; He has seen the Father. Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me has everlasting life. **I am the bread of life.** Your fathers ate the manna in the wilderness, and are dead. **This is the bread which comes down from heaven, that one may eat of it and not die. I am the living bread which came down from heaven.** If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever; and the bread that **I shall give is My flesh, which I shall give for the life of the world.**" The Jews therefore quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this Man give us His flesh to eat?" Then Jesus said to them, **"Most assuredly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you.** Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day. For My flesh is food indeed, and My blood is drink indeed. **He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood abides in Me, and I in him.** As the living Father sent Me, and I live because of the Father, **so he who feeds on Me will live because of Me. This is the bread which came down from heaven—not as your fathers ate the manna, and are dead. He who eats this bread will live forever.**" These things He said in the synagogue as He taught in Capernaum. Therefore many of His disciples, when they heard this, said, **"This is a hard saying; who can understand it?"** When Jesus knew in Himself that His disciples complained

about this, He said to them, **“Does this offend you? What then if you should see the Son of Man ascend where He was before? It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life.** But there are some of you who do not believe.” For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were who did not believe, and who would betray Him. And He said, “Therefore I have said to you that no one can come to Me unless it has been granted to him by My Father.” From that time many of His disciples went back and walked with Him no more. (NKJV)

You are assigning value to the Word of God. The Word of God is producing life in you because you place a value on it and choose to believe it.

1 Thessalonians 2:13 For this reason we also **thank God without ceasing**, because when you received the word of God which you heard from us, you **welcomed it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which also effectively works in you who believe.** (NKJV)

Acts 19:18-20 And many who had believed came confessing and telling their deeds. Also, many of those **who had practiced magic brought their books together and burned them in the sight of all.** And they counted up the value of them, and it totaled fifty thousand pieces of silver. **So the word of the Lord grew mightily and prevailed.** (NKJV)

Acts 28:23-31 So when they had appointed him a day, many came to him at his lodging, to whom he explained and solemnly testified of the kingdom of God, persuading them concerning Jesus from both the Law of Moses and the Prophets, from morning till evening. And **some were persuaded by the things which were spoken, and some disbelieved.** So when they did not agree among themselves, they departed after Paul had said one word: “The Holy Spirit spoke rightly through Isaiah the prophet to our fathers, saying, ‘Go to this people and say: **“Hearing you will hear, and shall not understand; And seeing you will see, and not perceive;** For the hearts of this people have grown dull. Their ears are hard of hearing, And their eyes they have closed, **Lest they should see with their eyes and hear with their ears, Lest they should understand with their hearts and turn, So that I should heal them.”**’ Therefore let it be known to you that the **salvation of God has been sent to the Gentiles, and they will hear it!**” And when he had said these words, the Jews departed and had a great dispute among themselves. Then Paul dwelt two whole years in his own rented house, and received all who came to him, preaching the kingdom of God and teaching the things which concern the Lord Jesus Christ with all confidence, no one forbidding him. (NKJV)

Luke 5:15-24 However, the report went around concerning Him all the more; and great multitudes **came together to hear, and to be healed by Him** of their infirmities. So He Himself often withdrew into the wilderness and prayed. Now it happened on a certain day, as He was teaching, that there were Pharisees and teachers of the law sitting by, who had come out of every town of Galilee, Judea, and Jerusalem. And the **power of the Lord was present to heal them.** Then behold, **men brought on a bed a man who was paralyzed, whom they sought to bring in and lay before Him. And when they could not find how they might bring him in, because of the crowd, they went up on the housetop and let him down with his bed through the tiling into the midst before Jesus. When He saw their faith,** He said to him, **“Man, your sins are forgiven you.”** And the scribes and the Pharisees began to reason, saying, “Who is this who speaks blasphemies? Who can forgive sins but God alone?” But when Jesus perceived their thoughts, He answered and said to them, “Why are you reasoning in your hearts? Which is easier, to say, ‘Your sins are forgiven you,’ or to say, ‘Rise up and walk’? But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins”—He said to the man who was paralyzed, “I say to you, arise, take up your bed, and go to your house.” (NKJV)
